3. 4. Discuss and Take Appropriate Action on the Proposed LACAHSA 2024 Guiding Policy Questions as introduced by the Budget and Administrative Ad-Hoc Executive Committee. (This item was continued from the meeting of March 27, 2024) (24-1077)

Vice Chair Rex Richardson presented the Proposed LACAHSA 2024 Guiding Policy Questions as introduced by the Budget and Administrative Executive Ad Hoc Committee. He added that the proposed Guiding Policy Questions are a preliminary policy platform that establishes LACAHSA's key goals and prepares the LACAHSA to receive and strategically deploy funding at scale. Vice Chair Rex Richardson further added that the Executive Ad Hoc Committee developed an initial set of guiding questions to help spearhead this policy platform, and the full LACAHSA Board's feedback is needed to move forward.

Vice Chair Rex Richardson introduced Edwin Peart, Associate with LeSar development consultant to present the item.

Edwin Peart introduced himself to the Board and indicated that the Budget and Administrative Executive Ad Hoc Committee has worked on developing key topics and questions to engage and serve as a general guide for LACAHSA's 2024 Board meeting agendas and conversations, and to move forward to developing a broader regional vision and targets.

Isela Gracian (Alternate for Chair Holly J. Mitchell) acknowledged the one-year anniversary of the LACAHSA Board which held its first meeting in April of 2023. She indicated that the current placement of LACAHSA is appropriate, and the foundation, which is critical for the future work, has been set by the LACAHSA Board.

Alternate Board Member Lourdes Castro Ramirez (for Board Member Karen Bass) and Board Members, Alan Greenlee, Jonathan Jager, Kome Ajise, Almas Sayeed, John Mirisch and 2nd Vice Chair Miguel A. Santana collectively addressed the LACAHSA Board and recommended that the following questions and recommendations be considered to be added to LACAHSA's Guiding Policy Questions document:

 How might LACAHSA serve as a regional leader and advocate to help address historic inequities and disparities in affordable housing?

- How might LACAHSA build an indicator that allows the agency to measure whether LACAHSA's work is leading to a reduction in the number of people that are struggling to pay rent or mortgages?
- How might LACAHSA: a) be more detailed about the number of units of affordable housing it is creating; b) define what affordable housing means (i.e., households that make less than 30% needed for housing); c) create housing near job sectors and resources, and d) address infill and alternate land banking and utilizing other planning approaches to expedite creating affordable housing?
- How would LACAHSA identify and set time based measurable objectives that are reflected in a strategic plan that is updated as needed?
- What is LACAHSA's overarching policy on equity and ensuring no net loss of affordable housing?
- How might LACAHSA best ensure affordable housing public education is conducted on parallel tracks with overall policy and strategic development and funding opportunities so that the public is aware of affordable housing opportunities and resources?
- How might LACAHSA set forward a policy direction that ensures outreach to state and federal funding opportunities?
- How might LACAHSA ensure environmental justice and sustainability principles are captured within its policy efforts, programmatic build out, administration and direction (e.g., benchmarking and community input on these issues as well)?
- How might LACAHSA remain informed or aware of external factors (e.g., age income, income inequality etc.) that influence affordable housing—are there algorithms or other methods available to use to ensure LACAHSA remain informed as it makes decisions and applies funding to programmatic focus?
