



Renter Protection and Homelessness Prevention Program Emergency rental assistance funds are now available

The program will provide emergency rental assistance and flexible financial help to renters who are at risk of losing their housing due to a recent financial crisis, such as job loss, medical expenses, or other unexpected hardship.

Eligible households must:

- Live in Los Angeles County
- Rent their home
- Have income at or below 80% of the Area Median Income, and
- Have experienced a housing-related emergency within the past 12 months.

Through this program, eligible renters may receive financial assistance to help stabilize their housing as well as case management and referrals to other supportive services, delivered by trusted community-based partner organizations in our collaborative.

Applications must be submitted through a case manager at one of the following organizations:
